APRS

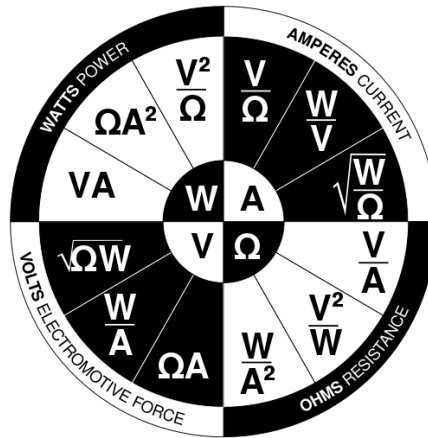
AUTOMATIC PACKET REPORTING SYSTEM

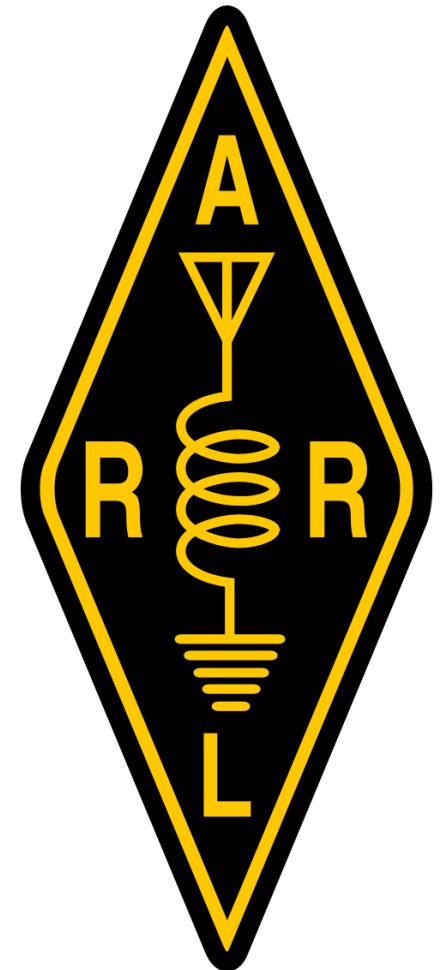

GET ON THE AIR!

IMPORTANT LOCAL REPEATERS

SHELTON, WA

2 meters – The N7SK repeater is at 146.720 MHz with a PL tone of 103.5 and a negative offset of 600 kHz.

70 centimeters – The N7SK repeater is at 443.250 MHz with a PL tone of 100 and a positive offset of 5 MHz.

BELFAIR, WA

2 meters – The NM7E repeater is at 145.170 MHz with a PL tone of 103.5 and a negative offset of 600 kHz.

BREMERTON, WA

2 meters – The WW7RA repeater is at 146.620 MHz with a PL tone of 103.5 and a negative 600 kHz offset.

OLYMPIA, WA

2 meters – The K7CPR repeater is at 145.470 MHz with a PL tone of 100 and a negative offset of 600 kHz. Packet radio is at 145.63 MHz (simplex).
